

## Grounds For Elimination (Partial Listing)

It is the rider's responsibility to know the rules. If a rider unknowingly breaks a rule, they will still be eliminated.

### **IN ALL PHASES:**

1. Missing your assigned ride time.
2. Unauthorized assistance (no one may talk to competitor while in ring)\*.
3. Riding without a helmet.
4. Dangerous Riding - horse out of control (may be eliminated or penalized 25 pts.).
5. Excessively reprimanding (beating) horse or yanking on mouth.
6. Horse is lame.

### **DRESSAGE** (specific to the phase):

1. Entering before judge signals (whistle or bell).
2. Taking longer than 45 seconds to enter the ring after the judge signals.
3. Horse stepping outside of ring during test (all 4 feet).
4. Using an illegal bit (except VG & Intro divisions)
5. Riding with illegal equipment (spurs longer than 3/4", whip longer than 43.5").

### **CROSS COUNTRY** (specific to the phase):

1. Jumping a fence backwards (red flag must be on your right).
2. Missing a fence on course.
3. Refusing 3 times at a fence. After elimination, leave course at a walk.
4. Refusing 4 times total on course. After elimination, leave course at a walk.
5. Missing the finish flags (must go through the flags).
6. Fall of rider.
7. Fall of horse.

### **STADIUM** (specific to the phase):

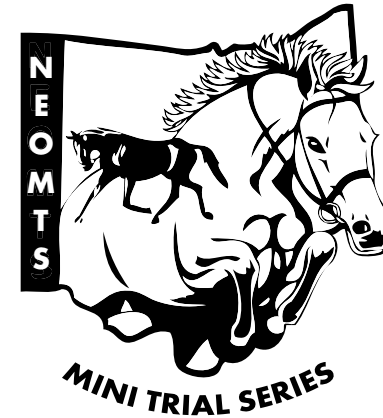
1. Starting course before judge signals (whistle or bell).
2. Missing the start/finish flags (must go through the flags).
3. Refusing 3 times total on course. **(Circling on your stadium course counts as a refusal - one refusal per circle).**
4. Jumping fences in wrong order or jumping a fence backwards.
5. Fall of rider.
6. Taking longer than 45 seconds to cross the start line after the judge signals with a whistle or bell.
7. Fall of horse.

### **EXCEPTIONS:**

Only in the Intro division will Unauthorized Assistance (UA) be allowed. The competitor will be assessed a one time penalty of 50 points, even if UA occurs multiple times. They will not be eliminated. Examples of acceptable instruction/direction (i.e. "go through the finish flags"). In extreme cases, the trainer may attach a lead line to the competitor's horse to help them complete the course. Assistance may NOT be given in the dressage ring. UA occurring in the dressage ring is grounds for elimination.

Note: Dressage readers are allowed in Intro & VG and are not considered UA as long as the reader does not coach the competitor.

## SECTIONS

**OPEN/RIDER SECTIONS:** Each of the six divisions are divided into two sections. The first section is called "open". This section is for horses and/or riders with experience at levels higher than the division being entered. Professionals may compete in these sections. The "rider" section is for less experienced riders on horses of any experience level. Professionals may not compete in the rider division.

## DIVISIONS

**TRAINING DIVISION:** The Training division is recommended for competitors who have successfully competed a year or more at the novice level. This is a standard USEA division. The cross country course may include banks, water, ditches and drops. Note: Cross country fences and stadium fences may be up to 5'3" wide at the base and up to 3'3" high. The stadium course will emulate a jumper course. Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast or too slow on cross country, and too slow in stadium. This division is for experienced eventers. (Maximum heights/widths will probably not be reached). XC optimum time: 420mpm. Speed limit: 520mpm.

**NOVICE DIVISION:** The Novice division is recommended for competitors who are confident cantering and jumping obstacles. This is a standard USEA division. The cross country course may include banks, water, ditches and drops. The stadium course will emulate a jumper course. Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast or too slow on cross country, and to slow in stadium. Pony Club recommendation: strong C-1's. XC optimum time: 350mpm. Speed limit: 450mpm.

**BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION:** The Beginner Novice division is recommended for competitors who are confident cantering and jumping obstacles. This is a standard USEA division. The cross country course may include up banks, water & ditches. The stadium course will emulate a basic jumper course. Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast or too slow on cross country, and too slow in stadium. Pony Club recommendation: C-1's, strong D-3's. XC optimum time: 325mpm. Speed limit: 420mpm.

**STARTER DIVISION:** The Starter division is recommended for riders who are comfortable cantering and jumping small obstacles, and horses with some experience. The dressage test consists of walk, trot & canter and 20m circles. The cross country and stadium course consist of simple jumping efforts. Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast on cross country. Stadium is not timed. Pony Club recommendation: D-3's, strong D-2's. XC optimum time: 280mpm. Speed limit: 350mpm.

**VERY GREEN DIVISION:** The Very Green division is recommended for lower level riders with basic jumping skills or inexperienced horses. The dressage test consists of walk, trot & 20m circles. The cross country and stadium course consists of straight forward jumping efforts (same course as Starter Division) Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast on cross country. Stadium is not timed. Pony Club recommendation: D-2's. XC optimum time: 240mpm. Speed limit: 325mpm. Dressage reader is permitted.

**INTRO DIVISION:** The Intro division is recommended for lower level riders who would like an introduction to eventing or for inexperienced horses. The dressage test consists of walk, trot & 20m circles. The cross country course & stadium course may be completed at the walk, trot or a combination of the two. Penalty points will be accrued for going too fast on cross country. Stadium is not timed. The stadium course will consist of small cross rails, verticals & brush boxes. Pony Club recommendation: D-2's, strong D-1's. XC optimum time: 200mpm++. Speed limit: 325mpm. Dressage reader is permitted.

++ Optimum time (OT) for Starter, VG and Intro are for breaking ties only. No penalty points accrued for going too slow, just for going too fast.

**Protective vests, ASTM/SEI helmet & a ground person are MANDATORY. Medical armbands are recommended.**

**HELMET RULE:** In accordance with the USEF helmet rules for Dressage and Eventing, the Mini Trials Series will require that all riders must wear properly fitting protective headgear which passes or surpasses ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Harness must be secured. So if you still own one of those flimsy little helmets, toss them out as you won't be able to wear them at any competitions.

**Refunds:**

RRHPC respectfully requests that competitors read & understand the refund policies. Please note that events such as these require many costs to be fronted by the Pony Club, a non-profit youth org. Our club depends on this fundraiser for its existence & fronting these costs without profit would result in the inability to maintain the event grounds & the RRHPC mini trial in the future. Help us keep eventing in our area by respecting these policies.

1. Up until closing date of July 23, refund will be given upon cancellation of entry minus \$20 admin fee.
2. NO refunds will be given after July 23 unless a letter from a vet is given & verified by RRHPC. In the case of a vet letter, refund will be given minus a \$20 admin fee.
3. On-site stabling is limited to the first 48 paid. Off-site stabling within 10 miles will be found for those paid after on-site is filled. If competitor does not wish to be off-site, a refund for stabling only will be given. Refunds for event entry will be given only if no off-site stabling can be found within 10 miles **AND** the competitor is traveling over a distance greater than 50 miles.
4. In the extremely unlikely event that the event is cancelled due to no fault of the club (ie. dangerous weather or natural disaster) refunds will not be given. This is due to the fact that up front costs & regular maintenance of the grounds is necessary and a missed year of this fundraiser would mean the inability to maintain our grounds & would, therefore, close our doors. Help us keep eventing going in our area by understanding the need to have this policy. This has never happened in the history of our event.

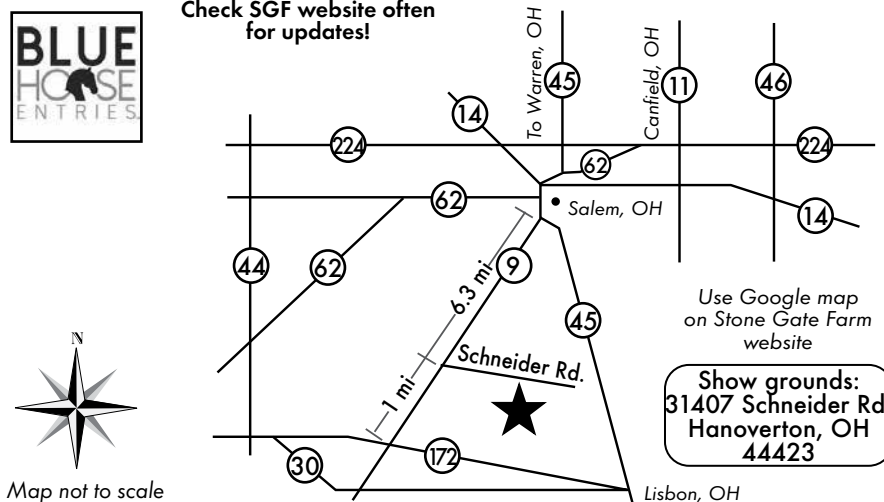

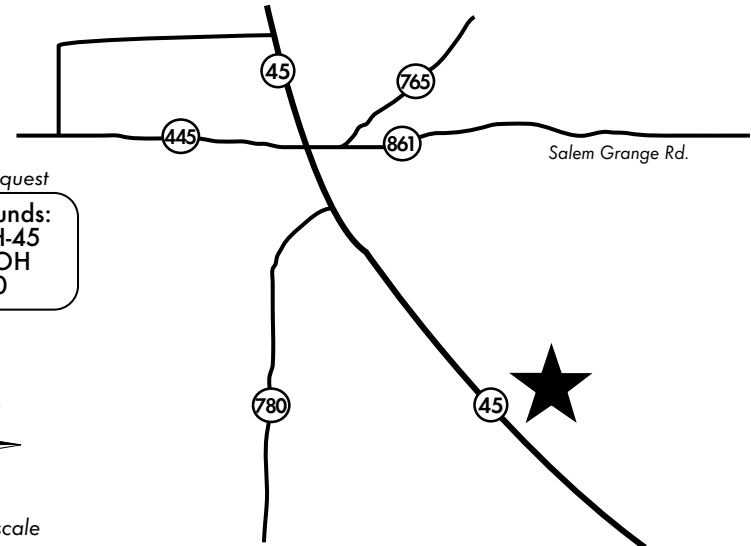
